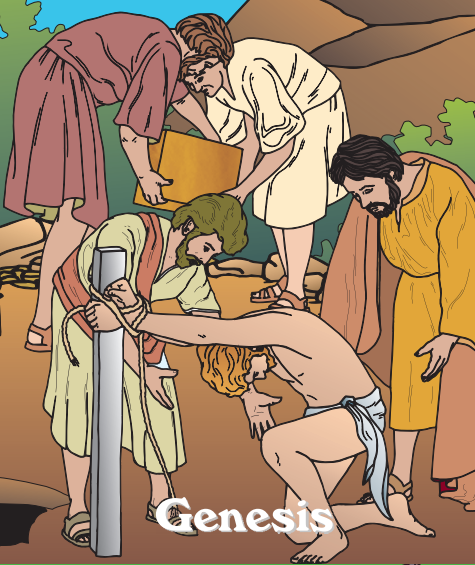

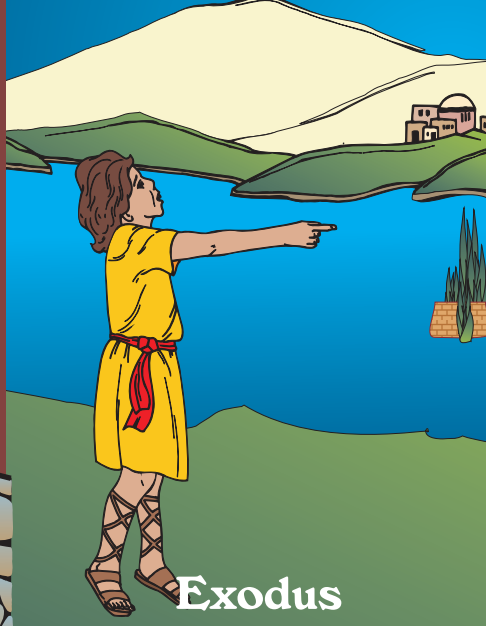

Patriarchs

"When the LORD saw that Leah was not loved, He opened her womb..."
Gen. 29:31

- Sons of Leah and Jacob
- Judah was father to the Kings of Israel, as well as Jesus
- Judah saved Joseph from death by proposing his sale to the slavers
- Issachar means "laughter"; Zebulun means "dwelling"; Judah means "praise"

"The sons of Rachel's maidservant Bilhah: Dan and Naphtali. The sons of Leah's maidservant Zilpah: Gad and Asher."
Gen. 35:25-26

- Asher means "happy"
- Gad means "blessed"
- Moses praised Gad for his bravery
- Dan means "judgment"
- Naphtali means "my wrestling"

Patriarchs

"Simeon and Levi are brothers--their swords are weapons of violence."
Gen. 49:5

- Reuben (means "behold a son") lost his birthright by betraying his father
- Levi (means "joined") became father of the Priests
- Simeon (means "God hears") was a violent and harsh man

"But Jacob did not send Benjamin, Joseph's brother, with the others, because he was afraid that harm might come to him."
Gen. 42:3-4

- Rachel died giving birth to Benjamin
- Jacob loved him like Joseph
- His named was changed from "son of my pain" to "son of my right hand"

High Priest

- Aaron was three years older than his brother Moses
- Acted as spokesman for Moses, doing miracles before Pharaoh
- Appointed high priest of Israel by God
- Made the golden calf
- Sons included Nadab, Abihu, and Eleazar

Lawgiver

- Born Hebrew, but raised as an Egyptian prince
- Fled Egypt after killing an Egyptian
- Chosen to lead Israel from Egypt
- Talked to God and performed miracles
- Brought down the ten commandments

Prophetess

Exodus 2:7

- Older sister to Moses and Aaron
- Watched over Moses on the river
- Called a prophetess
- God gave her leprosy when she rebelled against Moses

- Levite slaves in Egypt
- Parents of Miriam, Aaron and Moses
- Left Moses in a basket for the Egyptian princess to find
- Jochebed raised Moses as his nurse
