
The Walls of Jericho—Rahab, Spies and the army of Israel.


- 1. Read the story of the conquest of Jericho in Joshua 2, 6 and 7.

- 4. Use the images on the wall to tell the story of how Rahab hid two spies, the men of Israel marched around the walls seven times and God gave them the victory by collapsing the walls.












Straw on Rahab's roof. Fold in half and place on the top of the wall.

Garment to hide in Achan's tent.








Gold and silver to hide inside Achan's tent.






Achan's tent. Cut out and fold in half.
